Their lightweight ends and narrower diameters allow a bow person to get a secure grip on the pole during maneuvers.

Each DTC pole is handcrafted by Forespar's technicians in Southern California and is available in base diameters from 4 to 12 inches. Owners specify the necessary taper ranging to 3" on a 4" diameter pole, all the way down to 4" on a 12" diameter pole. Other aspects of the pole design such as Kevlar patches, color and end fittings can also be ordered to fit. They are simply the finest downwind poles available.
